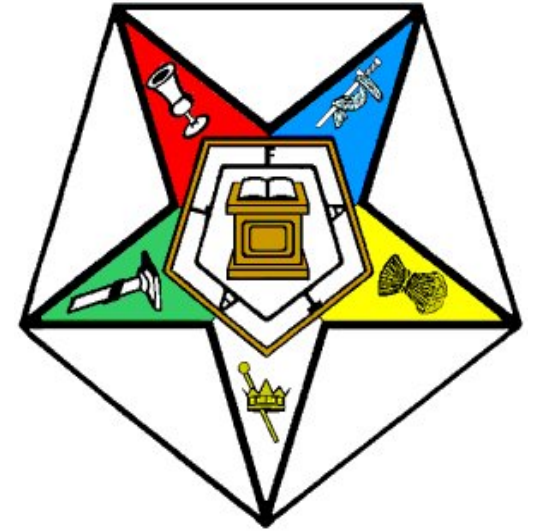

Purposes

Eligibility
