Swope Park Family,

As many of us are aware (and as I'm sure this issue discusses further), our building has recently fell victim to a theft of the copper in our air conditioning system. While this came as a hit to us personally through very warm and/or cancelled meetings, we were also impacted financially. I would like to personally and on behalf of the Building Board thank each of you for your support in providing funds and assistance to support replacing the air conditioners and increase our security to prevent this from happening again.

Each organization that meets at our building donated to assist in paying for the insurance deductible, including the youth organizations. This goes to show how much each of us care for one another. Rather than throwing our hands up and saying that it wasn't our fault, everyone extended their arms out and gave their time and money to help others.

I would like to thank Brother James Parkinson in particular who was crucial in getting our air conditioner replaced. He worked late nights and weekends in order for our groups to be able to meet as quickly as possible. I would also like to thank our Building Board Secretary Worshipful Brother James Payne and Right Worshipful Brother Larry Cameron who worked with the insurance company and organized both the replacement of the air conditioner and the upgrade of security systems.

We now have an updated security system which I encourage each of the members to become familiar with and use as you enter and exit the building. We also have installed an upgraded security camera system with 16 cameras that provides a display of the perimeter of the entire lodge to two flat panel LCD TVs, one by the entrance of the lodge room and one downstairs in Shotwell Hall. There is also a PC in the lodge room which will automatically log on to the system and display the cameras at the secretary's desk. Members and guests are also welcome to log into the system to provide that "extra eye" on the building from their smart phones, tablets, and laptops. Instructions will be available for users to log into the system.

Future upgrades to the building are also in the works. We'll keep you informed of the progress as the plans are solidified, but a new sound system is one known area that is on the list for upgrading in the near future. Parking lot improvements are also going to be needed soon, and we are in the initial planning stages for those upgrades.

BRAVE DEMOLAY BOY HONORED



(June 19) Members of the Swope Park York Rite bodies honored a brave DeMolay boy with a plaque and cash award for action taken last April 11th when a fire broke out in a two story home at 210 W. Dakota street in Butler while seven people slept- but thanks to the quick actions of two teens, everyone escaped the fire that eventually consumed most of the structure. Two adults were downstairs while five children upstairs were trapped by flames in the stairwell. 14 year old Dakota Hulse, who was spending the night, along with another teenager acted quickly by lowering the other children from a second story window onto a rooftop, then safely to the ground. Dakota, a member of Thirteen Brothers DeMolay chapter, went back into the house to find a five year old girl as soon as they determined she had not gotten out. The girl was functionally dead, not breathing and with no heartbeat. She was revived by CPR and suffered broken ribs. Dakota was admitted into the hospital having suffered from smoke inhalation. The brave action of the boys got everyone out alive, especially the little five year old girl who was saved by Dakota. VANDALS STEAL COPPER LINES FROM AIR CONDITIONERS

(May 14) The Lodge building suffered a major loss after thieves cut and took the copper lines from our 15 ton and 5 ton A/C unit compressors. They gained access into the fenced area on the east side of the building from the roof. The \$ 15,700 loss was partially covered by our property loss coverage, netting our loss to the \$ 2500 deductible. The Building Board held a special meeting the following Sunday to approve replacing the units and upgrade the security system and implement measures to prevent future incidents. We are adding additional security cameras and an intrusion alarm sensors. The system will be monitored 24/7 by a security company in communication with the KC police department.
